Title	Study on Security of Social Networks
Summary	<p>Social networking services (SNS) have changed the Internet communication styles. Furthermore, the open Application Programming Interfaces (APIs), are introduced to provide a channel by which the third-party applications can interact with SNS. As expected, the SNS and third-party apps formed into SNS ecosystems. Meanwhile, the attack surfaces of SNS are extended and some new security issues need to be concerned. In this presentation, insecure development, new security threats, and coordinate counter plans of SNS and third-party apps against these issues will be covered. In order to detect Web APIs related security weaknesses, we also designed an efficient detection tool and corresponding operation process.</p>
